Vintage Swing Trio

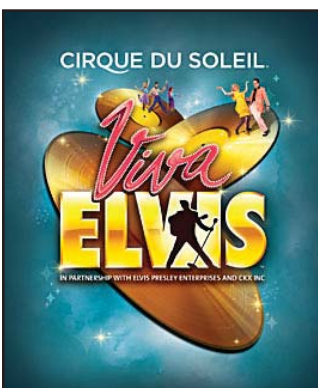
